

Questions Asked by Supervisor Hooker @ November 19, 2019 Public Hearing

Before we reconvene, I request the following:

- 1. A well-advertised telephone number in place for use of surrounding residents including those in the Bradshaw Road and the Transportation Corridor to call in complaints and maintain an open complaint log shall be open to the public.*

A postcard (see attached) with the requested notification information has been compiled and has been mailed to surrounding residents as requested. A complaint log is available at RVRA's main office and is open to the public to view during the Authority's normal operating hours. Additionally, an item has been added to the Authority's monthly meeting agenda to include any and all complaints/comments (written & verbal) received during the month along with any action/response taken by Authority staff in response.

- 2. An email address that is well-advertised for the same purpose.*

RVRA's email address is included on the post-card (see #1 above), along with instructions for submitting questions/comments to RVRA via RVRA's website.

- 3. I would also like to request regularly scheduled community meeting to share information and concerns and hold one meeting prior to revisiting the SUP.*

The Authority assisted the Bradshaw Citizens Association (e.g. the "Host Community") with its incorporation, including the establishment of regular community meetings. These meetings have traditionally been hosted by the Authority at the Smith Gap Landfill and RVRA staff provide updates to the Host Community and respond to any concerns voiced at these meetings.

To date, the Authority has hosted public meetings specifically pertaining to the transportation option it has been considering to convert its rail spur to a road and truck MSW via the Transportation Corridor into the Smith Gap Landfill on: December 1, 2016; September 18, 2017; and October 17, 2019. Formal Public Hearings have been held on November 4, 2019 (RoCo Planning Commission) and November 19, 2019 (RoCo Board of Supervisors).

Per your request, a public meeting has been scheduled on March 9, 2020 at the Masons Cove Elementary School from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

- 4. Masons Cove community meeting concerns answered in writing along with citizen concerns that I handed Dan Miles prior to this meeting.*

Responses to questions/comments posed at the October 17, 2019 Public Meeting will be provided in a separate document.
